#### TO REGISTER FOR CLASSES

Classes are open to laborers who are employed by contractors contributing to the Wisconsin Laborers' Apprenticeship & Training Fund.

You must register for classes either on a browser on a computer, tablet, or cellphone, or by downloading an app for your smartphone.

#### TO REGISTER FOR CLASSES ON A WEB BROWSER

- Go to <u>liunawisconsin.org</u> using Chrome, Safari, Firefox, Microsoft Edge, or another web browser.
- Click the menu tab on the top left-hand corner of the screen.
- Click on "Training Center Course Registration"
- Click on the "REGISTER" box of the course date of which you'd like to register for, this will prompt you to the log in page.
  - Enter your Union Card Number OR your Training ID Number.
  - First time users, below this you will put the last four digits of your social security number and select Log In. You will be directed to another page to change your password. Your current password is the last four digits of your social. You will need to make up your own password.
  - For members that are returning enter your password you created the last time you were logged in.
- You can use the select a course arrow button to see the courses that are being offered; select a course, it will bring you to the definition of the course, select "Continue" to see what dates are available for this course and to register. Select the date you wish to register for and select "Continue," if everything looks right, select "Submit." This does not guarantee you a seat in a class, you are in a pending status, and someone will reach out to you. You will be sent a letter with your scheduled class dates.
- When you select the "Class Registration" on the top of the page you will see your current class enrollment and pending registrations. You can also register for a class on this page.
- Reminder, this will put you in a pending status and someone will reach out to you.

  - For members that are returning enter your password you created the last time you were logged in.
  - Click "Log In."
- Click on the three lines on the top right-hand corner.
  - Select Class Registration.
  - Click on Register for a class.
- Select a course you want to attend or learn more about, it will bring you to the definition of the course, select "Continue" to see what dates are available for this course and to register. Select the date you wish to register for and select "Continue," if everything looks right, select "Submit." This does not guarantee you a seat in a class, you are in a pending status, and someone will reach out to you. You will be sent a letter with your scheduled class dates.

Attention Apprentices! You may not cancel your course online, and instead you must contact Wisconsin Laborers' Apprenticeship Coordinator Ray Wiatt at (608) 846-5764 or rwiatt@liunawisconsin.org.

Apprentices need 144 training hours per season, and a total of 400 training hours to graduate from their registered apprenticeship.





#### LODGING

For multiple-day classes, the option of staying at the hotel that the Wisconsin Laborers' Apprenticeship & Training Fund provides is available to laborers who live 50+ miles from the Training Center.

#### TRANSPORTATION

Laborers who are staying at the hotel will be reimbursed for mileage from their home to the Training Center and back.

Laborers who are commuting and not staying at the hotel will be paid \$20/day. Check payments will be made upon the completion of the class.

If you ride with someone else also attending a class at the Training Center, you will not receive any mileage allowance.

#### MEALS

The Wisconsin Laborers' Apprenticeship & Training Center does not provide meals. Students should bring their own lunch. Large coolers, microwaves, snack and soda machines, paper plates, napkins, silverware, and coffee are provided.

#### UNION CARDS AND WORK CLOTHES

Members should be paid up on their local union dues to attend classes. Students are required to wear pants, shirts with sleeves, and work boots. The Training Center will provide hard hats and safety equipment, but you may bring your own hard hat if you wish.

#### REPORTING WITH INJURIES TO THE TRAINING CENTER

Classes at the Training Center are primarily handson, involving the physical work of a construction craft laborer. The Training Center does not have the resources to restructure classes to each individual who may have a temporary injury.

- 1. When a class involves physical work, participants may not enroll in the class if they are currently unable to work as a construction craft laborer because of an injury, whether work-related or non-work-related.
- 2. When a class does not involve physical labor, but rather classroom lectures and written materials, participants who are unable to work because of an injury, whether work-related or non-work-related, may enroll in the class.


