Minimum Requirements to Apply

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Must have the physical ability to perform the work of the trade with or without reasonable accommodations
- Must have reliable transportation

Any individual entering the Wisconsin Laborers' registred apprenticeship program must be tested prior to starting work. Our program requires a reading and arithmetic component. ACT, Accuplacer, or Next Generation Accuplacer are accepted testing methods. Qualifying testing scores are good for up to 5 years from the acceptance date but need to be updated annually until you find a sponsor.

- ACT 15 Reading & 14 Arithmetic
- Accuplacer (Classic) 55 Reading & 35 Arithmetic
- Accuplacer (Next Generation) 236 Reading & 220 Arithmetic

What can I expect while training?

- Apprenticeship program is approximately 3 years
- On-the-job training with an experienced journeyworker
- Travel to jobsite and to training center
- 400 hours of PRI (Paid Related Instruction)
- 4,000 hours of OJT (On-The-Job Training)
